make his relinquishment of his right of the s<sup>d</sup> Negro we do therefore  
Obligate ourselves to pay him for the part which he might legally due  
in s<sup>d</sup> Negro & we do hereby warrant & will forever defend the title of  
s<sup>d</sup> Negro to the s<sup>d</sup> Lucy Picket her Heirs & assigns forever against the  
claim of the s<sup>d</sup> Hume And against the claim of all & every person or persons  
whatsoever In Testimony whereof we have hereunto set our hands & seals the  
17<sup>th</sup> day of December 1810
